CMSA JUNIOR ROSHAAN SIDIQQUI EARNS <u>FIRST</u>® TECH CHALLENGE (FTC) DEAN'S AWARD

Chicago, IL – (May 9. 2017) – Chicago Math and Science Academy (CMSA) proudly announces that Roshaan Siddiqui, a founding member of the robotics team, "The Robotitans Team #7006," has received the honor of being one of six students to win the 2017 FTC Dean's List Award. The prestigious award was created by <u>FIRST</u>® Robotics founder and inventor Dean Kamen. Roshaan is one of only *six students in* the United States to receive this honor. The award was presented at the recent Robotics World Championship in St. Louis.



"Five years ago, Roshaan Siddiqui joined the robotics team as a 7th grader. His years of hard work and dedication led him to win this Dean's List Award. Thousands of students from 33

countries are involved in robotics, but only 6 students received the Dean's List Award and Roshaan is one of them. We are so very proud of Roshaan and know that this award will open many doors for him," states Mr. Akgul, one of his robotics coaches.
